

Ready to Achieve! 2021-2022 Reopening Plan (8/13/2021)

University View Academy has always operated as a virtual school with an online learning model. Students will continue to work remotely from the safety of their homes for the 2021-2022 school year. Teachers and staff will report to offices as scheduled by school leadership.

All employees and visitors (both vaccinated and unvaccinated) to school buildings will be required to wear a mask.

University View Academy does not provide transportation to any school-related events. Inperson proctored testing, field trips, or any other events where students will be present will be scheduled and facilitated in accordance with federal and/or state guidance. Fully vaccinated and unvaccinated adults will not be required to wear masks at outdoor events; however, physical distancing measures should still be enforced.

- Proclamation #137 JBE 2021: Governor Edwards issued a statewide mask mandate for Louisiana effective 8/4/2021. This includes students in grades K-12.
- Regardless of school masking policy and vaccination status, all adults and students five (5) years of age and older are required to wear a face mask during school transportation.

Physical distancing requirements will determine the acceptable number of people allowed in a room for In-person meetings. University View Academy will encourage physical distancing of at least six feet from other adults in indoor settings. Room capacity should not be more than 50% of the allowable amount for in-person meetings.

University View Academy will encourage all parties to cover coughs and sneezes appropriately and wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol may be used.

No staff member or student should attend work or school-related events when experiencing COVID-19 related symptoms.

• Anyone with a 100.4+ fever may not remain at school and must be picked up immediately.

• Staff and students will be assessed, as needed, throughout the day for symptoms of COVID-19, as defined by the CDC.

If a staff member or student experiences any Covid 19-related symptoms, they should leave the school building or event site.

University View Academy will continue to limit all in-person events for school and staff to essential functions.

University View Academy will continue to monitor the social and emotional wellbeing of students and staff through virtual support measures.

University View Academy will notify employees of close contact with a positive confirmed case.

All University View Academy facilities will maintain proper cleaning supplies for daily use including soap, paper towels, hand sanitizers, and disinfectant. Staff will clean daily, and high touch surfaces will be cleaned throughout the day.
